The common causes of home-

You can make these places safer, but the most important thing to remember is to watch young children at all times. It only takes a minute for babies, toddlers and preschoolers to fall, run over to a hot stove, or put the wrong thing in their mouths. Your watchfulness is your child's best defense.

However, accidents will still happen, so it's important to be prepared.

~ Install smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors.

~ Place gates at top and bottom of all stairs.

~ Install childproof latches on cabinets, drawers, and so on.

~ Place outlet covers on all empty electrical outlets that children can reach. Make sure that these covers could not cause a child to choke.

~ Tuck electrical cords out of the way.

~ Lower hot water heater temperature to less than 130° F.

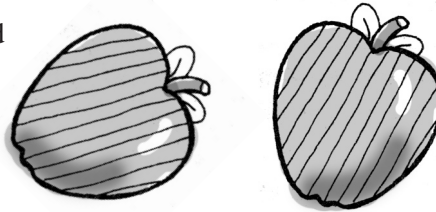

What to Do:

2. Together, cut each apple into four pieces with a plastic knife.
3. Invite your child to put the apples, honey, and a small amount of water into the blender.
4. Invite her to push the button and blend until smooth.

ENGLISH MUFFIN FACE PIZZAS

What to Do:

1. Put the pizza toppings on top with a spoon or plastic knife.
2. Encourage your child to use decorative foods creatively to make a face on the pizza. Talk about how each face needs eyes, a nose and a mouth. Add extra features such as eyebrows, eyelashes, hair and so on with cheese shreds.
3. Put pizzas under the broiler until cheese melts.
4. You might even take a photo before your child eats his creation.
